Ladies' and Misses' Slip-On Dress Closed Under the Left Arm. Waist Has V-Shaped Neck in Front and High Neck in Back Finished with an Attached Cape-Collar. Set-In, Dart-Fitted Sleeves Are Provided. Attached Two-Piece Circular Skirt with a Two-Piece Yoke. Width at lower edge of skirt, size 36, about $4\frac{1}{4}$ yards. 9 Pieces.

Proportionate Measurements

Length of dress at center-back from neck to lower edge, size 16, including hem, 46 inches; remaining sizes, 48 inches.

Before cutting, compare carefully all pieces of pattern with chart.

HOW TO CUT AND MAKE

$\frac{3}{8}$ inch has been allowed on all edges for seams and finishing.

TO CUT:—Place pieces of pattern on material with edge marked by a group of three small perforations ••• on a lengthwise fold of material, and place remaining pieces on material with lines of triple small perforations ••••• on a lengthwise thread of material.

Double large perforations OO OO indicate gathers.


Natural waistline indicated by double small perforations underarm edges of waist front (1) and waist back (2).

TO MAKE:—**WAIST FRONT (1), WAIST BACK (2), COLLAR (3), TIE (4):**—Form dart under the arm in front waist (1), matching and stitching along corresponding lines of small perforations, running dart to a point at single perforation. Close shoulder and underarm seams as notched, easing in any fullness on shoulder of back section to fit front. Leave left underarm seam free below single large perforation in front (1) to finish for closing. Gather lower edge of waist between double large perforations. Join front ends of collar (3), matching single notches. Sew collar to neck of waist, matching notches and center-backs even. Tie a knot at center of tie (4) and tack it to neck of waist (over collar) at center-front.

FRONT HIP YOKE (5), BACK HIP YOKE (6), FRONT OF SKIRT (7), BACK OF SKIRT (8):—Join front and back hip-yokes, matching triple notches, leaving left side seam free above large perforation in front yoke to finish for closing. Sew yokes to lower edge of waist, matching single and double notches, center-fronts, center-backs, right side seams and left side edges. Join front and back skirt sections, matching double notches. Turn under $2\frac{3}{8}$ inches at lower edge of skirt for hem. Sew skirt to lower edge of yoke, matching single notches, center-fronts, center-backs and seams at sides.

SLEEVE (9):—Form dart in sleeve, matching and stitching along corresponding lines of small perforations, running dart to a point at single perforation. Close seam of sleeve as notched, easing in any fullness between notches; leave seam free to about 3 inches from lower edge to finish for closing. Sew sleeve in armhole as notched, large perforation at shoulder seam and seam of sleeve at underarm seam, easing in any fullness.


For more dressy occasions you'll adore it in black transparent velvet with the cape collar of deep ecru lace.
